Children's Residence provides support and relief services for families of children who have a special needs, up to the age of 19.

The residence is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week by skilled and experienced AiMHi employees. The atmosphere resembles that of a home, including single and double bedrooms, a dining room, a large fenced yard, and ample space for play activities.

We welcome your children to stay during the following times:

- Parental relief
- Emergencies

While staying in the Children's Residence, your child will have the opportunity to increase their independence, while making new friends.

Responsibility

AiMHi owns and operates the Residence. The Ministry of Children and Family Development requires a support service agreement to be completed before a child can be cared for at the Residence.

Cost

The Ministry of Children and Family Development provides the operating budget and referrals for the residence and there may be a user fee.

Based on availability there may be opportunity for private contracting.
