

## *Frequently Asked Questions*

### *What is the Contractor's role?*

The role of the contractor is to provide a home and support for a person with special needs. Roles vary depending on the person you are matched with. We are looking for people who share our vision of community.

### *Who will I be matched with? Do I get a choice?*

Yes you do get a choice. At AiMHi we match people and contractors based on personalities and lifestyles.

### *Do I get paid?*

Yes. Home Share Contractors receive payment from AiMHi on the 15th of each month for that current month. The person also pays them a monthly Home Sharing Service Fee.

### *What if I need a break?*

Contracts include funds to be used for respite. People who provide respite for you meet the requirements for respite providers listed in your contract.

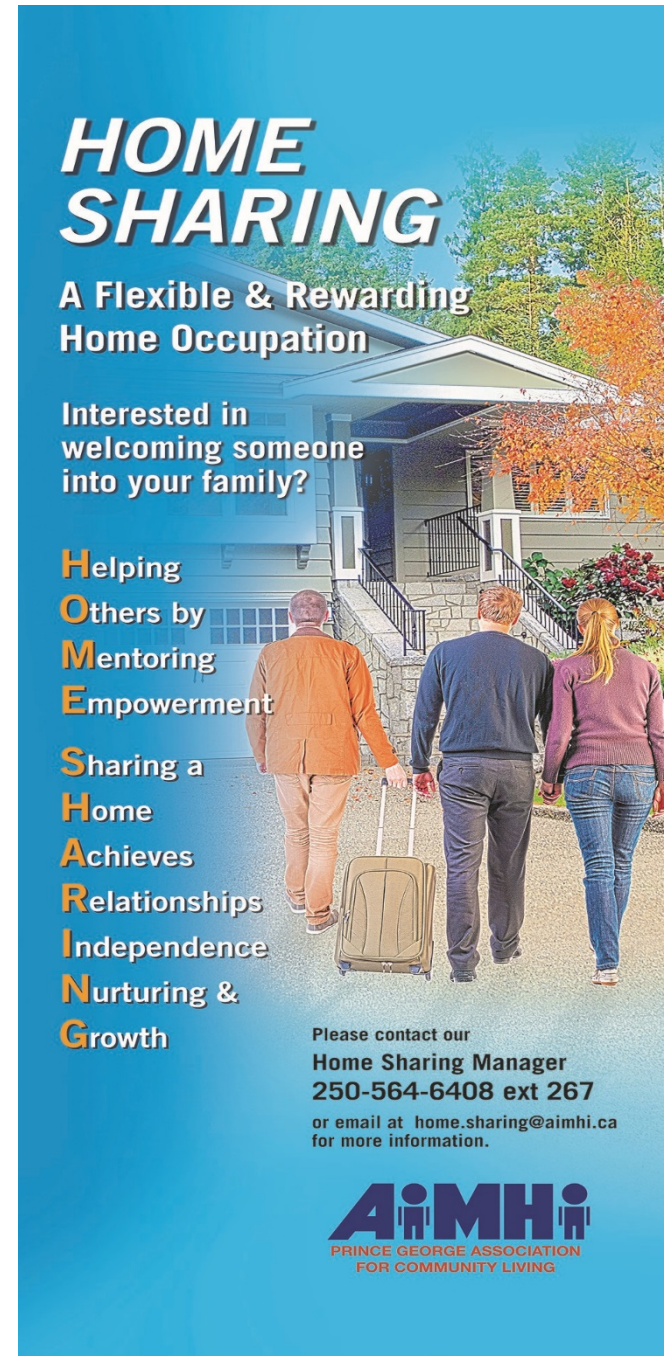

# ~Home Sharing~

## *What is Home Sharing?*



Home Sharing is a living option for a person who has a developmental disability where they share a home with someone who provides ongoing support. Support may include assistance in daily living skills, training to develop their independence, self-care, relationship-building, life skills, and access and use of community resources and activities. Referrals to receive Home Sharing services are made through CLBC.

Home Sharing providers will be matched with the specific needs, interests and lifestyle preferences of the person receiving the support. There will be many considerations involved in selecting an appropriate Home Sharing contractor for each person, while we seek to find the best matches for everyone!

## Requirements of Prospective Contractors:

- 19 years of age or older
- Mature and flexible
- First Aid and CPR Certificate
- Criminal Record Search and TB Test
- Medical clearance
- Class 5 Drivers License
- Drivers Abstract
- Work/character references

### Assets:

- Post-Secondary Education and/or training in Community Living
- Experience with people with disabilities

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There are two support services  
available within the  
**Home Sharing Program**

1. **Home Sharing** ~ Full-time Residential Care
2. **Respite** ~ Periodic care to provide Home Sharing providers with an opportunity to take time away.
