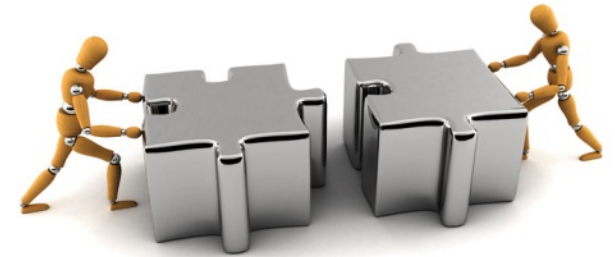
Infinite Employment Solutions and Life Skills Mackenzie
